Entry to Game

- Fans with dogs must use Gate 7 alongside W Berry Street.
- No dog will be allowed inside the park without a completing the Bark in the Park attendance waiver.
- Only one dog may be permitted per Authorized Dog Handler.
- Authorized Dog Handler will be provided a wristband.

Seating Options

- All Dogs must be on a leash at all times and handled by the owner. Retractable leashes are not permitted.
- All owners and dogs must be seated in the designated spot in GA seating near center-field.

Dog Waste & Water

- Grassy area inside the fence by the 1st Base Patios (normally Kids Day Area on Sunday Games) will be allocated the Dog Play Area and used for dog waste and water. (We will have signs for this area and a marketing representative can be present at all times.)
- Water will be served in a community style in the Dog Play Area as well.
- Marketing will purchase doggy bags that owners are required to use. We will give each dog one bag upon arrival at the stadium and have others at the trash cans. All trash cans are OK to use for dog waste.
- Violators of these rules will be asked to leave Lupton Stadium immediately.

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GENERAL RELEASE OF CLAIMS AND COVENANTS NOT TO SUE

PLEASE READ THIS RELEASE CAREFULLY BEFORE YOU SIGN IT. BY SIGNING THIS RELEASE YOU WILL BE WAIVING LEGAL RIGHTS.

I, the undersigned, fully understand, appreciate and agree that I have voluntarily requested to participate in a "Bark in the Park" event (the "Event") at a Texas Christian University ("TCU") baseball game ("Game") to be played at Lupton Stadium (the "Stadium"), which will involve my attendance and the attendance of one dog of which I have custody, at the Stadium. I understand that by participating in the Event, my actions may result in anticipated and/or unanticipated injuries and damage to myself and others including my dog, as well as the dogs of others.

I hereby represent that the dog of which I have custody during the Event is in good health and has current rabies, DHHP, and Bordetella vaccinations. I understand that no dog will be allowed admittance to the Stadium and the Event unless I have provided documentation acceptable to TCU in their sole discretion that the dog that will be in my custody has current vaccinations. I agree to abide by any decision of any TCU official, employee, staff, or other authorized representative concerning my ability or the ability of the dog of which I have custody to participate safely in the Event, and I further agree that TCU officials, employees, staff, and other representatives may authorize necessary treatment for me and/or the dog in my custody.

I agree to abide by all the rules and instructions given by to me by TCU in connection with the Event, and to provide accurate information regarding my dog as requested by TCU in connection with the Event. I understand that I am solely responsible for the accuracy of any and all information that is requested by TCU in connection with the Event, and I agree to release the Released Parties, as defined below, from liability and any responsibility for verifying such information whether the information was provided by me or a third party.

I assume any and all risks associated with my participation and the participation and actions of my dog in this Event including, but not limited to, risk of or associated with injury and property damage including injury to dogs, illness, falls, contact with spectators at the Event, injuries or damages sustained by and through other participants dogs, the condition of the premises and the Stadium, including all sidewalks and parking lots, and it is understood and agreed that all such risks are assumed by me.

I agree to abide by all rules and instructions established by TCU in connection with this Event as well as all rules and regulations imposed on all ticketed patrons attending a Game at the Stadium (including without limitation the right to require my removal from the premises and the Stadium together with the dog in my custody in the sole discretion of TCU). I assume the risk for injuries and damages sustained as a result of the manner and method by which the Event is administered.

I acknowledge that I have completed the "Bark in the Park 2025 Application" provided by TCU. I understand that I am solely responsible for the accuracy of information that is contained therein and I hold the "Released Parties" (as that term is defined below) released from liability and any responsibility for verifying the information contained in the application and whether the information was provided by me or a third party.

INITIALS OF OWNER

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IN CONSIDERATION FOR ALLOWING MY DOG AND ME TO PARTICIPATE IN THIS EVENT WITH THE DOG IN MY CONTROL, I HEREBY FOR MYSELF, MY HEIRS, EXECUTORS, AND ADMINISTRATORS OR ANYONE ACTING ON MY BEHALF, WAIVE, RELEASE, AND COVENANT NOT TO SUE AND FULLY INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS AND DISCHARGE TCU AND EACH OF THEIR RESPECTIVE AGENTS, PARTNERS, OFFICIALS, EMPLOYEES AND REPRESENTATIVES, ANY SPONSOR OF THE EVENT, SUPPLIERS, AGENTS, AND INDEPENDENT CONTRACTORS OR OTHER PERSONNEL IN ANY WAY ASSISTING OR CONNECTED WITH THIS EVENT (ALL OF SAID PARTIES BEING COLLECTIVELY REFERRED TO HEREIN AS THE "RELEASED PARTIES"), FROM AND AGAINST ANY AND ALL CLAIMS, DEMANDS, OR CAUSES OF ACTION OF ANY KIND (INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, ATTORNEYS' FEES AND COSTS THROUGH ALL APPEALS AND OTHER PROCEEDINGS) ARISING OUT OF MY PARTICIPATION AND THE PARTICIPATION AND ACTIONS OF MY DOG IN THIS EVENT, REGARDLESS OF WHO CAUSES THE INJURY OR DAMAGE SUSTAINED AND REGARDLESS OF WHETHER BASED ON FAULT OR NEGLIGENCE OR NOT. I UNDERSTAND THAT MY DOG WILL NOT BE ALLOWED ADMITTANCE UNLESS AND UNTIL I AGREE TO ASSUME FULL RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE ACTIONS OF MY DOG.

I agree that if I commence, join in, or in any way seek relief through any action or proceeding arising out of, based upon, or relating to any of the Claims released hereunder, or in any way assert against the Released Parties any of the Claims released hereunder, then I will pay to the Released Parties, in addition to any other damages caused to the Released Parties thereby, all attorney fees incurred by the Released Parties in defending or otherwise responding to said action, proceeding, and/or Claims.

The undersigned hereby grants permission to record and utilize, use, reproduce, publish, and depict the videotaped or photographed image, likeness and/or voice of the undersigned, and the image and likeness of the dog in the undersigned's custody, as well as the undersigned's name and any other identification for advertising, publicity, instructional or any other purposes in connection with the Event or the business of any of the Released Parties, in any medium from time to time without compensation or notice to the undersigned.

The undersigned acknowledges that he or she has (i) had full opportunity to ask any questions regarding the Event that the undersigned may have and fully understands the nature of the Event, (ii) read and understands this document ("Release"), (iii) been given an opportunity to review this Release with anyone the undersigned chooses, including a lawyer, (iv) given up substantial rights by signing this Release and (v) full power, right and authority to sign this Release and has freely and voluntarily signed this Release.

None of the Released Parties shall have, or be deemed to have, any obligation to the undersigned, their dog, or any other person in connection with the Event unless set forth in writing and signed by the Released Party.

This Release is meant to be liberally construed to protect the Released Parties to the fullest extent allowed by law.

THE UNDERSIGNED FURTHER ACKNOWLEDGES AND AGREES THAT THIS RELEASE IS GOVERNED AND INTENDED TO BE AS BROAD AND INCLUSIVE AS PERMITTED BY THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF TEXAS. IF ANY PORTION OF THIS RELEASE IS HELD INVALID, IT IS AGREED THAT THE BALANCE HEREOF SHALL CONTINUE IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT.

By signing this release, I am confirming I am eighteen (18) years of age or older. I acknowledge that I am not required to participate in the Event and can withdraw from participating in the Event at any time. My participation is voluntary and solely for my benefit and entertainment. I will not be compensated by TCU, or any other person or entity for my participation in the Event. I will notify TCU in writing, not less than forty-eight (48) hours prior to the date of the Event, of any reasonable accommodations, auxiliary aids, and/or services, as defined by the Americans with Disabilities Act, that I may require in order to participate in the Event. I hereby acknowledge that the failure to so notify TCU will be deemed a representation by me that no such accommodations, auxiliary aids, and/or services will be required by me in order to participate in the Event.

I, the above mentioned Owner ("Owner"), hereby acknowledge that my voluntary participation in the "Bark in the Park" event (the "Event") at Lupton Baseball Stadium at Williams Reilly Field (the "Stadium") located at 3700 Berry Street, Fort Worth, TX 76129 on Wednesday, April 29th, 2026 may result in personal injury to me and/or my above mentioned dog ("Dog"). By participating in, attending and/or observing the Event, I acknowledge and assume all risk and danger to me that are incidental to or in any way arise from the Event, including, without limitation, all risks and danger inherent in a canine-oriented event (e.g. dog bites, fights or altercations, falls, contact with spectators at the Event) or the sport of baseball (e.g., thrown and/or batted balls, thrown bats, or contact or collision with any other persons).

I accept personal responsibility for any and all actions of the Dog and agree that the Dog will be in my care and control during the Event. I hereby represent and confirm that the Dog is in good health and current on all vaccinations, including rabies, DHHP and Bordetella, and that the Dog is not the subject of a quarantine order, a pending adjudication or administrative hearing, and has never been declared a dangerous, potentially dangerous or vicious or potentially vicious dog. I agree to be bound by the terms of rules and regulations established by the TCU Athletic Department and TCU for both the Stadium and the Event, and I will abide by all applicable governmental laws, ordinances, orders, directions, rules and regulations, as well as all rules and regulations that are adopted for this Event by the TCU Athletic Department or any of its affiliates. I acknowledge TCU reserve the right to exclude or eject any and all unruly, rowdy or disruptive Owner or Dog from the Event and/or the Stadium without liability and that I shall be fully responsible for any damages or expenses, direct or indirect, incurred as a result of my or my Dog's disruptive behavior and/or ejection. I further agree that any Stadium official may authorize necessary treatment for me and/or the Dog in the event of injury.

I hereby protect, indemnify, defend and hold harmless the TCU Athletic Department, TCU and any of its affiliated entities, including without limitation, _____, from and against any and all actions, causes of action, claims, suits, demands (or other legal actions), losses, damages, costs and/or expenses (including, without limitation, reasonable attorney's fees and disbursements) for personal injury, property damage or any other injury or loss of any kind arising out of, in connection with, or resulting from my and/or my Dog's participation in and/or attendance at the Event, regardless of who caused the injury or loss sustained and regardless of whether based on fault or negligence or not.

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IS YOUR DOG RIGHT FOR BARK IN THE PARK?

YES IF YOUR DOG:

- Is old enough to be around other dogs and people (at least 4 months of age)
- Is up to date on all required vaccinations
- Is in relatively good health and can walk up and down several flights of stairs
- Does well on-leash and is not overly aggressive toward other dogs
- Is friendly toward humans and not excessively fearful
- Is a **Horned Frogs** fan!

NOT IF YOUR DOG IS

- Is still too young to mix with a big crowd (under 4 months)
- Is a senior dog that would have trouble navigating stairs and being outside for an extended period of time
- Has aggressive tendencies towards other dogs or humans while on-leash (or off)
- Is a **UTA** fan! (Just kidding, all are welcome!)

Is your dog exhibiting any signs of illness close to the day of the game (i.e., cough, nasal discharge, lethargy, diarrhea, etc.)? These symptoms can be signs of potentially infectious illnesses and it would probably be best for your dog as well as the other dogs in attendance, if they did not attend.

Older dogs, dogs with short muzzles and/or dogs in general that are quickly prone to heat exhaustion should consider not attending this event or possibly plan on not staying for the entire game. The direct sun and heat can be a deadly combination for dogs. Dogs cool themselves down by panting and are not nearly as efficient as us humans. Please keep the comfort and safety of your dog in the forefront of your mind when planning out this fun day at the park.

You are responsible for your dog's behavior at the event. Watch your dog for signs of stress that can lead to inappropriate behavior at all times.

Watch for and signs of stress in your dog that could lead to confrontational behavior:

- Tail straight up and stiff, staring at other dogs.
- Hair raised on their backs
- Lip licking and avoidance of other dogs or people.
- Repetitive stress signals like yawning, heavy panting, or lip licking

During dog interactions keep an active attention on your dog, watch for body language that could indicate anxiety or stress.

When Humans Greet Dogs:

- Greet the owner first and ask the owner if it is OK to greet their dog
- Ask the dog if he would like to meet you, pat your leg and call him over. Do not approach dogs that are not interested in meeting you.
- Do not offer food to a dog other than your own without the owner's permission.

When Dogs Greet Dogs:

- Dogs sniff each other - this is a universal and appropriate way for them to greet.
- If both dogs show relaxed and calm body language, allow your dog to sniff and be sniffed by others.
- If your dog is avoidant of other dogs or is uncomfortable with being sniffed and approached by stranger-dogs he may not enjoy an outing to the park!
